Honey Cake Instructions

Ingredients: 6 oz/175 g self raising flour, 4 oz/110 g honey, 2 oz/50 g sugar, 3 eggs, 6 oz/ 175 g butter/ margarine (approx weights)

Method: Bake in 2 x 7inch/18 cm tins for 25 to 30 mins.

Cake filling: Cream together 2ozs/50g margarine, 2 tblsps Irish Honey, 3 ozs/75g icing sugar.
